#### Quartet entertainment

**“Final Four”** Qualifiers from Flights “A” thru “D” are reassembled into four different quartets. After two are eliminated, the “Final Two” quartets exchange tenors and basses and then sing two matches whose scores are combined to determine the winning quartet. In case of a tie, a one song ‘sudden death’ round will be sung.

**Individual High Score Metal** The individual with the highest number of punched holes in his yellow card may claim this award. If he has also qualified for the “Final Four”, he must choose one of the other. If he chooses not to go to the “Final Four”, the next highest scoring person in his voice part sings in the “Final Four”.

**Chapter Trophy** Each chapter attending should have a team captain, who will collect his five Chapter members’ cards following the “D” light round. The five members with the highest number of punched holes will be awarded the Chapter Trophy. Chapters with less than five competitors may enlist no more than three otherwise obligated competitors to fill out their team, representing a single chapter.
